School Garden Produces Bumper Crop

During its first year, the FFA garden, located at the high school, has been producing a bountiful harvest of produce for the upcoming school year. The garden, built in the last school days of May, has been maintained by FFA members and Agricultural Education instructor Ryan McMichael. So far the biggest producer has been cucumber plants, which have been processed into pickles and stored fresh to use for the school lunches. Most of the vegetables were planted later in the season so that the peak harvest would not start until school was in session. The garden will continue to be utilized until winter and FFA members will begin to plan for next year's crops. The entire project was funded by a grant from the Ohio Department of Education.

Bus Driver Retirement

A special thanks to Roger Luersman who has dedicated many years to Kalida Local as a teacher and bus driver. When he retired from teaching in 2008, he continued to substitute teach and drive as a substitute driver but after 40 years he has now decided to hang up the bus driving keys.
