Open House

The office will also be open to allow parents to pay book fees and lunch money, and purchase recorders for music, if necessary. Forms that are usually distributed the first day of school will also be available so parents have more time to complete them.

Drop Offs and Pickups

As in the past, we will use the front entrance (Fourth Street) for our drop off and pick up procedures. It is <u>extremely</u> important to use only the curb side nearest the elementary building when dropping off students in the morning. This is to ensure your child's safety so they do not have to cross in front of oncoming traffic. All students must enter the main doors by the office or the gym doors. Students being picked up at the end of the day are dismissed at 2:50. Cars must be gone by 2:55 so our 2nd round of buses may take their loading positions at that time.

Busing Information

The bus routes are complete. You will be contacted by your child's bus driver as to the pick-up time this year. Only bus drop off will be allowed at the gym entrance. Car drop offs are to be at the front door. If you have questions or have made changes to your child's busing schedule, please call the school.



Elementary Playground Structure

As we get ready to begin another exciting school year, we are also ready to kick-off the next step in our Elementary School Playground Project. It's time to finalize the structure plans and raise the last bit of money needed to make this dream a reality.

Our existing playground structure will soon be 25 years old. It's been maintained by the church, but is beginning to show its age. For the last 5 years, our PTO has been putting a portion of the money they raise toward a new playground structure for the students, and the Box Tops fund has also earmarked money for this endeavor. This structure will be built on the school owned property between the current structure and the elementary building.

In order to do this, we are putting together a Playground Grant Writing Committee to help with locating additional funds for the structure. Release Time

Cafeteria

Daily elementary lunches cost \$2.45, extra milk is \$0.50 and an extra entrée is \$1.50. Money should be sent in a sealed envelope with the child's name, PIN#, and amount written on the outside of the envelope. Account balances may be checked online. Free and reduced meal applications will be distributed at the Back to School Event or sent home on the first day of school. The reduced lunch price is \$0.40.
