- **Home Visiting** All Putnam County first-time moms are eligible for a one time visit.
- **Provide information** on infant care and activities to help your child reach developmental milestones.
- **Ongoing visits** are available to eligible first time pregnant moms or first time moms with a baby under 6 months of age. Call or visit our webpage for more information.
- **Early Intervention** Evaluation of any Putnam County child birth to age three for concerns relating to skills like talking, walking, or behavior and connections to ongoing specialized services.
