GRADE NINE THROUGH TWELVE 2019-2020

All students in Grades 9-12 will be required to have a pair of earbuds. They must:

- have a wired connection (no AirBuds, Bluetooth or other wireless headphones).
- only be in the ear headphones (no full-size or around the ear headphones).

- have a standard headphone jack or an adaptor to fit a standard jack (no Apple lighting jacks).

Students are expected to arrive on the first day of classes with pencil and paper ready to take notes. Specific supplies for each class will be announced at that time. Students are also expected to provide their own calculators. Students can check with their teachers to learn which models are best for the different math courses.
