

GRADE SEVEN 2022-2023

2 1-subject notebooks - 70-100 pages each (1 each for Science and Math)

1 2" 3-ring binder (Science)

1 binder with pockets and loose leaf paper OR a notebook and a folder (Language Arts/Reading)

3 folders with pockets

1 binder with pockets and loose leaf paper OR a notebook and a folder (Health)

5 folders with pockets

1 book cover

Blue or black pens

Red pens

GRADE NINE THROUGH TWELVE 2022-2023

All students in Grades 9-12 will be required to have a pair of earbuds. They must:

- have a wired connection (no AirBuds, Bluetooth or other wireless headphones).
- only be in the ear headphones (no full-size or around the ear headphones).
- have a standard headphone jack or an adaptor to fit a standard jack (no Apple lighting jacks).

Students are expected to arrive on the first day of classes with pencil and paper ready to take notes. Specific supplies for each class will be announced at that time. Students are also expected to provide their own calculators. Students can check with their teachers to learn which models are best for the different math courses.
