3 1-subject notebooks - 70-100 pages each (1 each for Science, Social Studies & Math)
1 2" 3-Ring Binder (Science/Social Studies)
1 2" 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper and binder tabs
Ruled index cards (3" x 5")
Blue or black pens
Five folders with pockets
